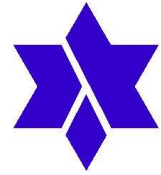




Congregation Am Tikva

This is a bittersweet time of year, signaling the end of summer, but also the arrival of the high holidays, with their opportunities for reflection and renewal.

We are pleased to let you know that Am Tikva will be offering a full complement of high holiday services and that we will be returning to a familiar setting - the auditorium at **Wheelock College (formerly Hebrew College) at 43 Hawes Street in Brookline**. The site is easily accessible by the Green Line (Beacon Street line) and has free parking.

Our annual roster of events includes the Pride Liberation Seder, participation in the Pride Interfaith Service, a "third" Passover Seder, and support for events such as the recent vigil in memory of the LGBT youth murdered in Israel.

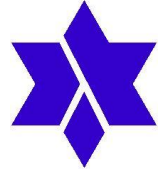

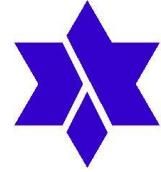
